Dear Parent/Carer

Roadworks which will affect the 940, 962, SMC4, 957, 958 & 959 bus services

Further to our recent communication informing you that there are going to be roadworks in the Cranbrook Avenue area (Cottingham Road end) we have now been informed that there has been a change to the date of these works. We have also had additional information regarding works to the railway line on Spring Bank West. **Please can we ask you to read the information below and ensure your child is aware of these changes.**

From Monday 10th May to Friday 28th May – the 940, 962 and SMC4 services will be affected, and the buses will follow the diverted routes as detailed below. From Monday 7th June these services will return to their normal routes.

940 (to get to St Mary's College the bus will take the following route, however the bus does not pick students up from Calvert Lane onward)

Anlaby Road/Hull Royal Infirmary, via Anlaby Rd Calvert Lane, **Calvert Avenue, County Road North, Fairfax Avenue, Hall Road, Inglemire Lane**, Cranbrook Avenue to ST MARY'S COLLEGE

The PM journey will be the reverse of AM journey

962 (to get to St Mary's College the bus will take the following route, however the bus does not pick students up from Calvert Lane onward)

First Lane Anlaby, Boothferry Road, Beverley Road, Northgate, Hessle Square, Hull Road Hessle, Hessle High Road, Summergroves, Tilbury Road, Gower Road, Anlaby Park Road, Anlaby Road, Calvert Lane, **Calvert Avenue, County Road North, Fairfax Avenue, Hall Road, Inglemire Lane** to ST MARY'S COLLEGE.

The PM journey will be the reverse of AM journey

SMC4 (AM ONLY)

Brough (ER Area) Brough (Welton Road), Elloughton Road, Welton Low Road (opposite Half Moon), through Welton, Parliament Street, through Melton, Melton Bottom, South Lawn Way, North Ferriby (Melton Road), Swanland (Kemp Road), Tranby Lane, Church Road (Kirkella), Beverley Road (Kirkella). From Beverley Road Kirkella the bus will then turn into a (Hull Area) service and will pick students up in the following areas: Spring Bank West, **right onto Walton Street, left onto Anlaby Road, left onto Park Street, left onto Spring Bank, right onto Chanterlands Avenue, left onto Cottingham Road, right onto Hall Road, right onto Inglemire**, Cranbrook Avenue to ST MARY'S COLLEGE.

SMC4 (PM ONLY)

St Mary's College, **Inglemire Lane, Hall Road, left onto Cottingham Road, Chanterlands Avenue, left onto Spring Bank West, right onto Park Street, right onto Anlaby Road, right onto Albert Avenue, left onto Spring Bank West** then the bus will continue with the normal route.

957, 958, 959

From Monday 24th May to Friday 28th May – the 957, 958 and 957 buses will be affected. These services will follow their normal routes but instead of travelling down Cottingham Road they will use **Beverley Road and Inglemire Lane.** **From Monday 7th June these services will return to their normal routes.**

Please ensure your child is aware of these works. If these diversions affect where your child embarks/disembarks the bus, please ensure that they know which stop they will need to use.

As a result of the COVID pandemic, we continue to ask our students to comply with the following:

- Pupils must sit in their designated seating area on our scholar bus services. They must move immediately to their area and remain in it for the entirety of their journey. Seating will be arranged in year groups.
- Pupils will only be permitted to travel on services where they have made an application in advance and been allocated a space.
- Pupils must wear their face mask for the duration of their journeys and in transit to and from their year zone. When they arrive at their zone each morning, students can remove their mask in designated outdoor spaces but must wear them inside school buildings. Tutors will invite pupils to remove their face masks once they are inside form rooms.
- Failure to behave in accordance with our school policy, consistently with our school ethos, or putting another pupil or the bus driver's safety or well-being at risk, will lead to the school's hierarchy of sanctions being applied and may result in a temporary or permanent ban.
